ASIAN AMERICAN LEAD PROGRAM INTERNS (Student Programs)

AALEAD promotes the well being of Asian American youth and families through education, leadership development and community building.

The AALEAD Intern will assist in implementation of AALEAD's various student programs and operations, which provides academic support and enrichment activities for low-income and at risk Asian American students. The AALEAD Intern will be assigned projects and programs that serve our AALEAD youth. S/he reports to the designated program coordinator.

The AALEAD Program Intern is responsible for the following duties:

- Assist in implementation and management of after school activities, specifically workshops addressing youth issues;
- Research issues that have an immediate impact on our students and create a series of workshops that address those student needs;
- Data entry; (related to grant work);
- Work with others to create a safe environment for students to learn and be themselves;
- Assist the Site Coordinator with additional tasks as needed;
- Compile a portfolio during internship .

Qualifications:

- Direct experience working with youth
- Good oral and written communication skills
- Sensitivity to the needs of refugee and immigrant children and families
- Attentive to details and strong ability to multitask
- Ability to work Monday-Friday schedule

- Recommended- Prior internship/job/work study experience(s) in social science, education, social work, liberal arts, or related field
- Recommended – Fluency in Vietnamese, Chinese, or Spanish

Time Commitment:

- Spring -3 months (February to May)
- Summer - 7 to 8 weeks (June to August)
- 12-25 hours, Monday to Friday, including 3:15-6:00 at least 2 afternoons a week.
